The Kinder High School for the Performing and Visual Arts (HSPVA), part of the Houston Independent School District, is a leading educational program for aspiring artists working within all creative landscapes. A Magnet school and previously named as a top school in the Greater Houston Area, HSPVA is known for fostering artistic growth and specializing in a diverse range of studies to encourage their students to enter various industries within the arts. M-M Properties and Kinzelman Art Consulting have partnered with the HSPVA program to curate a student and faculty exhibition, highlighting a broad selection of works created from various stages in each artist's life.

Educating age levels from ninth through twelve grade, HSPVA's programming is divided into six various creative departments: Instrumental Music, Vocal Music, Dance, Theater, Creative Writing and Visual Arts. This show, titled *Perspectives: A Selection of Student & Faculty Artwork from HSPVA* is a group exhibition featuring artworks in various styles and medias from both the visual arts department students and instructors. In allowing these works to comingle, the exhibition aspires to meld all age levels and points of view, encouraging the viewer to draw connections between each artist's personal understandings of the world we share.

Perspectives includes a wide range of artworks from abstractions and landscapes, to self-portraits and still lifes. A number of works included are derived from specific project-based assignments given to the students in class, whereas others are more loosely assigned, symbolizing each artist's personal creative journey.
